## Sec. 2 | Research Skill

The PYP program strives to provide multiple learning opportunities that support growth. At WRCA, the PYP program continues to develop in this area by providing students with opportunities for research through proper citation of academic resources.

As stated in the **WRCA Academic Policy** (revised Feb.2021), staff and students understand the importance of personal and academic integrity. Likewise, educators continue to develop good practices in learning and assessment.

This document looks at the **PYP Units of Inquiries** that focus on the **ATL Skill** of research. A support system is needed for students to record and document the resources used. Whether it be books, databases and websites, continual teaching of documenting sources used promotes best practices of academic honesty and integrity for grades Kindergarten to grade 5.

The long-term goal is for students to comfortably know how to show where they received their research information. In addition, students will be taught to use the WRCA library website exploring the databases as well as internet browsers (Chrome, Microsoft Edge etc.) to find reputable information effectively and efficiently. The LCMS teacher librarian has provided templates that are grade appropriate for students to show their resource list.

### BOOK (PRINT)

#### INFORMATION NEEDED

- Author's Last Name, First Name.
- 2 Authors: First Author's Last Name, First Name, and Second Author's First Name Last Name.
- *Title of Book (Italics).*
- **Publisher,**
- **Publication Date** (look inside the cover or the back of the book).

#### EXAMPLE (Book, print)

- Vermette, Katherena. *The Girl and the Wolf.* Theytus Books, 2019.
- Stevens, Janet and Susan Stevens Crummel. *The Little Red Pen.* Harcourt Children's Books, 2011.
- Bannister, Jerry, et al. *The Loyal Atlantic Remaking the British Atlantic in the Revolutionary Era.* U of Toronto P, 2012.

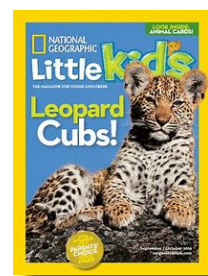
### BOOK (EBOOK)

#### INFORMATION NEEDED

- Author's Last Name, First Name.
- *Title of Book: Subtitle if Any. (Italics)*
- Edition if given and is not first edition,
- **Publisher Name** (often shortened), **Year of Publication.**
- Name of eBook Database,
- **URL/Permalink**

#### EXAMPLE (Book, ebook)

Calhoun, Craig. *Sociology in America: A History.* U of Chicago P, 2008. ProQuest Ebook Central, [ebookcentral.proquest.com/lib/up/detail.action?docID=408466&pq-origsite=primo](http://ebookcentral.proquest.com/lib/up/detail.action?docID=408466&pq-origsite=primo).



### MAGAZINE

#### INFORMATION NEEDED

- Author's Last Name, First Name.
- "Title of Article" (in quotations).
- *Magazine Name (Italics),*
- **Date of Publication, Day, Month, Year** (e.g. 2 Feb. 2019)
- **Page Numbers** (p. for single page, pp. for more than 1).

#### EXAMPLE (Magazine)

Jonas, Jack. "Leopard Cubs!" *National Geographic Kids*, 5 Mar. 1961, pp.4-8.

## ONLINE

[ If specific information is not available, move to the next step.]

### WEBSITE

#### INFORMATION NEEDED

- Editor, or Author's Last Name, First Name.
- "Title of Article or Page."
- *Name of Site (Italics).*
- **Name of Institution, Organization, or Publisher.**
- **Date the page or site was published.** (If available)
- **URL**

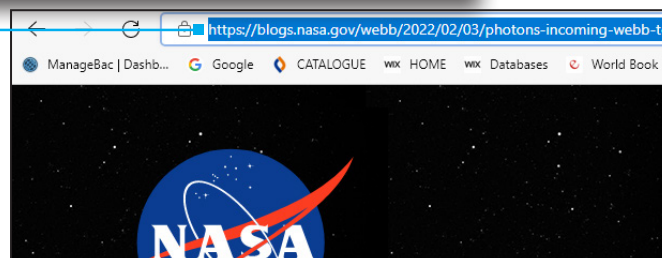

#### INFORMATION NEEDED

- Last Name, First Name of Photographer or Artist (Could be your name).
- Title of Work.
- **Date of Work** (Day, Month, Year).

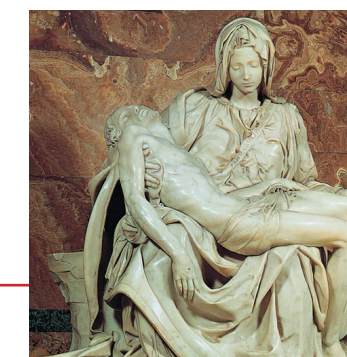


#### IMAGES FROM THE WEB

- Creator's Last Name, First Name. (If available.)
- "Title of the Digital Image."
- Title of Website.
- **Publisher, Date Published.** (Usually at bottom of the page.)
- **URL.**
- **Access date.**

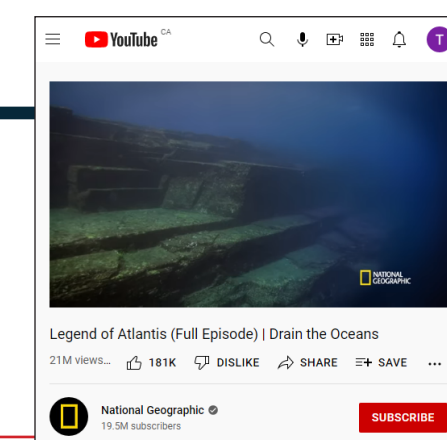

- "Title of Video."
- *Publisher (in italics), e.g. YouTube, Vimeo, WorldeBook*
- **Date Published.**
- **URL**

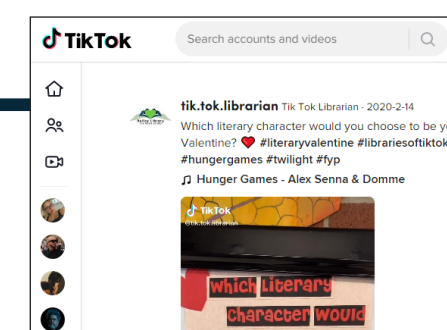
